About the Works

- 1. Drifting Sands and Liquid Amber** – Using gongs, bass drums, powered speakers, transducers, sine waves, water and sand, Drifting Sands makes visible the kinetic energy of sound.
- 2. Efference** – Two old corrugated tin roof sheets are turned into loudspeakers. Gently touch the metal to discover mysterious vibrations and sudden eruptions of sound.
- 3. Listening Boxes** - made of an old library catalogue, this box captures the sounds of Tyalgum through 16 discreet boxes. Listening, make your own sound, or compose you own piece. Pre-recorded sounds provided by Crystal Smith, Vanessa Tomlinson and the Garden of Light.
- 4. Bent Circuits** – Find the hidden sounds! Can you coax sound from all 3 instruments?
- 5. Making Waves** – sound travels in waves, but these three sound making machines produce the wonkiest sound waves ever. Try your hand at Springtime Sticks, Rotorwaves or The Wonker.
- 6. Scatter** – From a 3 metre-high spinning rotor hang two blue tooth speakers, scattering sound waves through the air and creating hypnotic pulsations.
